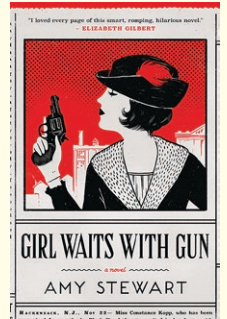

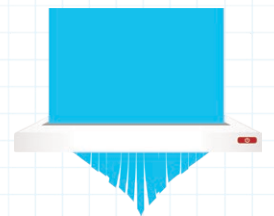


Shred Day
