The Green Hills Public Library District Board of Trustees met at the Library on April 20, 2026.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Barry moved, and Stratakos seconded, that the Board of Trustees approve minutes of the Regular Board Meeting held on March 16, 2026. Upon a voice vote, all Trustees present voted "aye." Motion carried.

OPERATING FUND TREASURER'S REPORT AND WARRANT

Jenkins mentioned Sonata is here all week to complete the mural in the Screened Porch Room.

Barry mentioned she really enjoyed the Library Spaces Survey Report and said there was a lot of valuable feedback. She is excited to see what becomes of all the different ideas. Jenkins mentioned that Product Architecture will be here at the May Board meeting to discuss the Capital Assessment Report.
